Vide reference 1, 3, 5 & 6 permission has been sought for laying the 700mm - 300mm DI pipes across the NH-66 from Kaavanad to Mevaram Junction. Vide reference 8, application documents and checklist were forwarded to NHAI and a follow up visit to NHAI office, Thiruvananthapuram was conducted on 21<sup>st</sup> December 2022, and it was directed to conduct a joint inspection with NHAI appointed consultant in-charge of the NH66 widening works.

Subsequently, a joint inspection was conducted on 27/12/2022 with the consultant firm appointed by NHAI(M/s Inspection Engineers) and representative of the contracting firm, M/s Shivalaya



Constructions Co. Pvt. Ltd., and it was informed that there does not exist any provision for the construction of utility ducts along the new work and currently only 500mm width pavement (non-uniform at some chainages) is proposed for carrying the existing utilities. It may be kindly noted that the construction of 100MLD Water Treatment Plant under Njankadavu scheme was designed incorporating the water demands for the entire Kollam Corporation and is scheduled for its completion by May 2023. Hence, it is very imperative and indispensable that these pipelines must be laid to ensure drinking water to the entire Kollam Corporation and the scheme to be successful. As there is paucity for funds for land acquisition and laying of these proposed pipelines are inevitable for providing drinking water to Kollam population, kindly requesting you to take necessary actions to accommodate our utility along the widening works.
